Details of Library Services & Programs

- You can access your account from our website (Search Southern Gulf Islands Libraries; choose Mayne Island).
- Log into My Account using your library card and password to see items out, items borrowed, and to renew items.
- Items can be borrowed for 21 days, with 2 renewals.
- Use your library card to download free eBooks, eAudiobooks, and eMagazines using the Libby app (by OverDrive).
- To get started with Libby, more info is on our website under "eLibrary". Need help on your device? Staff can show you how!
- Interlibrary Loans: looking for a book that our library doesn't have? Order free from other BC libraries. Use the "ILLUME" link on our website, search for titles and submit the form. We can also order these for you.
- BC visitors can use their home library card to borrow items under the BC OneCard program.
- Out-of-province visitors and others can be set up with a non-resident, temporary library card. Ask us!
