#### 10. EO Report

Motion to buy new projector recommended by Gord Miller, made by Gail Noonan, seconded by Emily Walker.

- Bingo: \$2322.04 spent on prizes and advertising, \$962.50 spent on Lauren fees (38.5 hours),
   \$3284.54 total. 12 players who submitted, total 134 entries, which have saved for future use. If do again, Jackie Henry has some ideas on how to improve participants. Would reduce number of prizes, which would reduce hours spent as well as prize costs. There was some perception

about squares being sponsored. They were to the degree that an attempt was made to have at least one square be applicable to a member business.
