Sailing from Tsawwassen (Vancouver), it takes around 1.5 hours to reach Mayne; from Swartz Bay (Victoria) a direct sailing will take around an hour. Reservations are highly recommended for travel from Tsawwassen; however they are not available from Swartz Bay on Vancouver Island. # Welcome

Mayne Island, also known as S,KTAK (sq-THECK) in SENĆOTEN, is within the traditional territories of the Straits Salish people. On S,KTAK is the Tsartlip Reserve #6, which gives our community a special relationship with the Tsartlip (WJOLELP) village near Brentwood Bay, who are part of the WSÁNEĆ First Nations. These are SENĆOTEN speaking people who have been here for millennia and who have rich heritage and traditional culture connected to S,KTAK. We extend our gratitude and our thanks to the WSÁNEĆ First Nations and acknowledge the privilege of enjoying this beautiful place in their territory.

Mayne Island is both peaceful and active, offering year-round meaningful joy and leisure. Immerse yourself in hiking, biking, kayaking, shopping, dining, beach combing, and relaxation.

While on Mayne Island you will see aspects of Mayne Island's roots, including: the Coast Salish "Honouring Figure" at Felix Jack Park carved by local carver, Johnny Aitken; WSÁNEĆ interpretive panels in front of the 1896 Gaol (jail), turned museum; and the Japanese Gardens at Dinner Bay Park honouring early Japanese residents and their contribution to island life prior to World War II.
